How To Edit & Print your Postcard

- 1. Before you do anything else, make sure this pdf is opening in a version of Acrobat Reader.
- 2. To create custom text with your congregation's name, navigate to the toolbar at the top, and select View, Tools, Edit PDF, Open
- 3. You should now be able to click your cursor in the text box and edit the labeled text.
- Navigate to the toolbar at the top, click on the File tab, and select the **Print** option. 4
- Once within the Print menu, make sure to check the Print on both sides of paper box. ഫ.
- Before printing multiple copies, it is always a good idea to print a test sheet to make sure they are printing in color, and correctly on both sides of the paper. . ف
- Once you print your test page, navigate back to the Print menu and select in the **Copies** box the number of cards you want printed
- If you want to print the connection card only, go to the Pages to Print section, and type "1-2" into the Pages box. . co
