## 2018-2019 GCI Photo Contest

### Guidelines for Photographs Submitted for Entry Into the 2018-2019 GCI Photo Contest

To be eligible, the photo must be of a Grace Communion International ("GCI") congregation or their weekly service or event, within the following categories:

1. Church Service (worship, prayer, communion, fellowship, etc.)
2. Community Outreach or Special Event
3. Church Programming (small groups, children's ministry, etc.)
4. Baptism
5. Facilities (church owned buildings and property)

Each photographer may submit a maximum of 5 photographs for entry into the photo contest.

Photographs submitted for entry into the photo contest become the property of GCI upon receipt of signed *Photo and Publicity Release & Permission to Reprint* document (the "Release") providing evidence that the photographer claimed ownership of the photographs submitted for entry and granted the right to GCI to use the photograph as provided in the Release.

GCI's Media team will review all of the photographs submitted for entry into the photo contest, select the top 15 photos from those entries, and then post the top 15 photos on GCI's Facebook page. The three photos receiving the most likes on GCI's Facebook page will receive monetary prizes. (1<sup>st</sup> place \$300 Amazon gift card, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$200 Amazon gift card, 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$100 Amazon gift card \*taxable for GCI Employees\*

GCI's Media team will contact each winning photographer after it has completed the selection process to inform the photographer that their photograph(s) submitted for entry have been selected as one of the top 15 photos for posting to GCI's Facebook page.

#### Photo Specifications:

Submitted photographs must have a file size of no more than 20 MB per image file. The recommended file format is JPEG/300 dpi.
