

- With this plan, you have access to the rich library of easyto-customize templates for professional quality graphics. Simply create a Spark account and start designing from hundreds of free templates.





Perks

Adobe Spark is an online site, which means you can access it anywhere you have internet, without needing to download a large program on your computer. It is user-friendly and has a guided tour to help you get started, as well as a list of pre-sized projects to choose from. You can create custom templates, but there is no need to start from scratch, as they already have templates for your project type with the correct dimensions. Not only can you create posters, Facebook images, and simple graphics, but they also have video templates that include a library of music and images to choose from. This site is fully integrated, meaning that instead of having to search the internet for free, legal images to use for your posters and invites, Adobe Spark has an image library connected to Unsplash and Pixabay, allowing you to search within your template for the perfect, free images to include.
