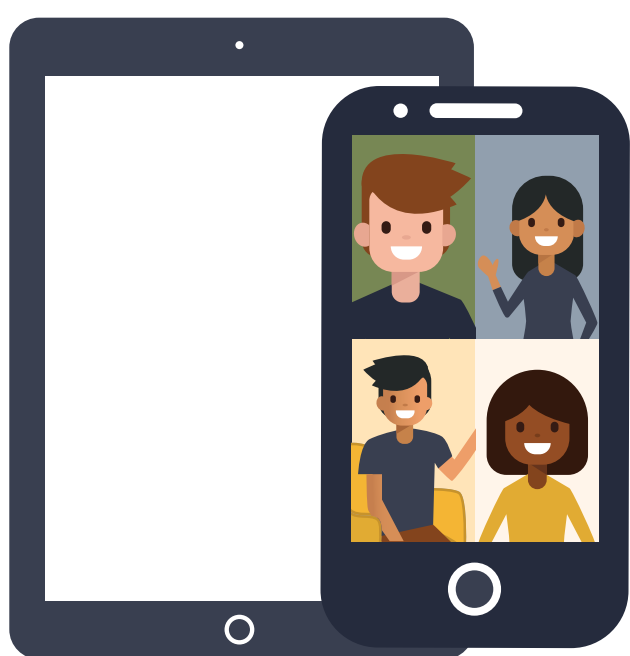




A Creative Guide to Online Children's Ministry



1. GAME NIGHT



Everyone can join in the fun of game night. Gather on a Zoom call and a virtual game using an app like [Houseparty](#) or [Jackbox](#).

2. SCAVENGER HUNT



Create a scavenger hunt of household items and then host a Zoom call. Have the youth participants bring the assigned items to share with the group. Another version would be to send your young members a list of items and have them post their photos to your church's Facebook group.

3. PEN PALS



How fun is it to get a surprise in the mail! Pair up each child with a member to write letters to or send crafts and other surprise goodies.

4. ACTIVITIES CONNECTED TO THE SERMON

5. LOVE AVENUE ACTIVITIES
