## WHAT IS A QR CODE?

QR is short for Quick Response. A QR code is a machinereadable label that when scanned redirects the scanner to a destination of the creator's choice. When you use your smart phone camera to scan the code, you are redirected to a link. This technology streamlines the process of both giving and receiving information. In this Church Hack, we will share a few examples of how churches can benefit from QR Codes.

#### Provide access to your connection card at a Sunday worship gathering or a Love Avenue event.
