20 MEDITATION MONDAY TITUS 2:11 (AMPC)

During this time, Christians traditionally foster a more contemplative attitude regarding self-examination practices. Perhaps Holy Spirit is urging you into "the desert" to refocus on who you are in Christ. The Holy Spirit led Jesus into the desert immediately following his baptism. It occurred right after the Father said to him, "You are my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." Our world can be so noisy and chaotic. Give yourself some space this Lent season to slow down, be quiet, and rest in your heavenly Father's warm hug of infinite grace as his dearly loved child.
