An essential part of a Healthy Church is the Faith Avenue. The Faith Avenue creates spaces outside of the Sunday gathering where discipleship can occur. Through the study of God's word, along with communion with God and one another, God is conforming us to Jesus' image through a life of faith and obedience.

We are excited to release the second workbook in the We Believe series. The We Believe curriculum is a resource formatted to explore our core beliefs through individual study and communal discussion. We Believe is grounded in Scripture and expressive of GCI's statement of beliefs and Incarnational Trinitarian Theology. In each section of We Believe, you will find questions in bold font followed by answers in standard-weight font. Following the answers are relevant references to verses in the Bible. The curriculum also includes a youth edition and two fillable workbooks, Part 1 and Part 2.

How to use We Believe in connect groups and discipleship classes:

- » Assign portions for participants to review and reflect on their own.
- » Come together for some fellowship (a meal, coffee, snacks, etc.) and read through the assigned section.
- » As a group, discuss and discover the personal impact of these truths about who God is.
 - · Select one or two questions to dig deeper.
 - Use the truths as a point of departure to discuss what might our response be to God.
 - Develop a devotional or meditation for the group to participate in based on the scriptures or characteristics of God in that week's selection.
