A hallmark of a vibrant and healthy church is the development of meaningful rhythms and relationships that extend beyond Sunday services. Connect groups play a pivotal role in fostering an inviting and nurturing atmosphere, enabling individuals to nurture their faith, find support, and cultivate deeper connections with Christ and fellow believers.

We are excited to release our Place-sharing curriculum. The purpose of these sessions is to reflect on the concept and practice of place-sharing as one potential way of living into the image of Jesus, the true place-sharer. In his incarnation, death, resurrection, and ascension, he shares the “place” of all humanity. Through three sessions, the curriculum guides the group to participate in Jesus’ on-going ministry by developing habits of place-sharing.

EACH SESSION LEADS THE GROUP THROUGH: DISCIPLESHIP CLASSES:



Icebreaker – a warm-up activity to aid group interaction.



Personal Exploration Small Group Discussion – a group conversation.



Video Lesson – an educational presentation covering the main concept of the session.



Small Group Discussion – questions for the group to process and apply what they have learned. interaction.



Personal Reflection – prompts that provide opportunity to process the session.
