Definition: a decision-making process in which an individual makes a discovery that can lead to future action.

In plain terms, it means understanding or knowing something through the power of the Spirit. Discernment is spirit-led and surpasses personal knowledge and experience.

2 different kinds:

- Discernment as a spiritual gift — divinely granted — nature
- Discernment through spiritual practices — theological and scriptural study, prayer, meditation and reflection — nurture

Discernment & Wisdom

Wisdom and discernment are closely related in the Bible. Wisdom actually has its source in discernment. When we study the Bible, we gain knowledge, but that knowledge only leads to wisdom when discernment is present.

A person can spend a lifetime studying Scripture but never gain wisdom because of a lack discernment.

Discernment is the ability to see and instinctually recognize subtle differences. Discernment allows one's knowledge to penetrate the cloudiness and cut through layers of confusion and ambiguity to perceive distinctions accurately. Wisdom is the product of insight and understanding gained through the ability to discern.

Discernment & Wisdom

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Gaining discernment or sound judgment involves trusting in the Lord, not depending on our own understanding, and seeking God's will.

King Solomon advised his son to hang on to discernment so that he would stay safe and secure on life's course:

Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. Proverbs 3:5–6 (NLT)

In GCI we understand the importance of prayer as the meeting point for discernment and strategy. Jesus, before choosing the twelve apostles, spent the entire night in prayer, emphasizing the connection between prayer and effective leadership postures. GCI encourages Christian leaders to build a solid foundation for their leadership through prayer, recognizing that having the mind of Christ enables them to implement strategies with Christlike discernment.

Reflect on your personal experiences in ministry, acknowledging times when strategies lacked spiritual insight and fell short. Discerning the lead of the Spirit is essential for envisioning a preferred future, and only then can effective strategies be developed to pave the way toward that future.

GCI Healthy Church vision encourages Christian leaders to follow the lead of the Spirit, discern where he is guiding them, and strategically participate with Jesus in his kingdom work. Discernment and strategies are not enemies but companions in effective ministry.



Discernment & Decision-Making

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Drawing inspiration from Jesus' ministry, GCI believes discernment and strategy are not mutually exclusive but rather complement each other.

While strategy is crucial in Christian leadership, it becomes truly effective when rooted in discernment guided by the Holy Spirit. Strategic efforts devoid of the Spirit's influence lack the discernment that comes from God's presence.

Jesus' leadership model was a demonstration of the harmonious companionship of discernment and strategy. Jesus strategically chose the twelve apostles, acknowledging their differences and potential challenges, yet bringing them together for a divine purpose. Jesus was able to discern qualities in individuals that were not immediately evident. Simon Peter, who became a significant leader in the early Christian movement, is a prime example of this.

Using Discernment in the Faith Avenue
