Truthfulness and respect for everyone are two of my core values.

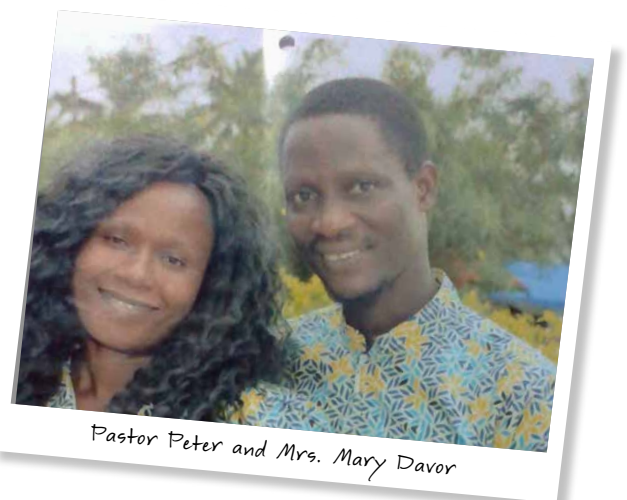
